Come out and show your motorcycle off at the “Bikes on the Bay” bike show in conjunction with Smokin’ in the Square.

Saturday – March 17th, 2018:

Registration is from 10:00 – 12:00

During registration, each rider will pay the \$20 entry fee.

Judging will start at 1:30 (all proceeds go to charity)

Awards will be given out at 2:30

A panel of judges will score all entries in the show and determine the winners. Awards will be judged by overall engine, paint & exterior appearance. Awards will be given 1st place in addition to “Best of Show.”

Categories are:

Sport – Also known as Crotch Rocket. Low profile and the rider is often lying over the tank.

Examples: GSXR, Ninja, CBR, RR, FJR

Cruiser— This includes the “in town”, light weight cruiser to slightly heavier bike that is also good for the open road. Typically between 500-700 lbs. dry weight.

Examples: Sportsters, Dyna, Vulcan, V Star, Classic, Vintage, V-Rod, Virago

Touring— The largest of the bike classes, this bike is made for long term trips. Typically over 700 lbs. dry weight. Often referred to as a Bagger.

Examples: Road King, Roadmaster, Vintage, Chieftain, Gold Wing, K1200LT, GTL, Nomand, Royal Star

Vintage – 1969 and earlier, all makes and models welcome.

Classic – 1970 – 1985, all makes and models welcome.

Builder – These are custom show bikes with lots of customization and individual creativity.

Trikes & Sidecars— Any trike or sidecar.

Rat— So ugly, you can’t believe it runs.
